Section Twenty One

Birim South District Assembly (Temporary Structure) Bye-laws, 2010
In exercise of the powers conferred on the Birim South District
Assembly by section79 of the Local Government Act, 1993 (Act 462), and in accordance with section23 of Fisheries Decree 1079 (AFRCD) these Bye-laws are hereby made:

Act 462

1. These. Bye-laws may be cited as the Birim South District Assembly

(Temporary Structure) Bye-laws, 2009 and shall apply within the area of authority of the Birim South District Assembly (hereinafter referred to as the Assembly).

Title

2. (a) No person shall erect a temporary structure as stated in the schedule without obtaining a permit from the Assembly.

Permit to erect

- 2(b). All permit granted under section 2a of this bye-laws are a kiosk subject for renewal every six (6) months from the time permit was granted.
- 3. No person shall erect a temporary structure for the sale of anything within the jurisdiction of the Assembly unless he or she has paid to the Assembly a fee that may be prescribed by the Assembly in a Fee Fixing Resolution.
- 4. Any structure constructed without authority from the Assembly shall be pulled down and the cost of pulling down the structure shall be charged against the owner.
- Any person who obstructs an agent of the Assembly in performance of his duties under section 4 of these Byelaws commit an offence and on conviction be liable for a fine not exceeding Twenty Ghana Cedis (GHC20.OO) or in default to a term of imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months.

Penalty

6. Any person who contravenes paragraph 2 of these Bye-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall on summary conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding (GHC200.OO) or in default of payment to a term of imprisonment not exceeding one (I) year.

Schedule

Structures constituting temporary structures included kiosk, sheds and the like.
