

EXCISE (SPIRITS) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS, 1965

IN exercise of the powers conferred on the President acting on the advice of the Cabinet by section 89 of the Excise Ordinance (No. 31 of 1953), these Regulations are made this 26th day of March, 1965.

1. The Excise (Spirits) Regulations, 1963 (L.I. 264) are hereby amended—

(a) by the substitution for regulation 1 thereof of the following :—

"Approval 1. (1) A distiller shall submit in writing to the of vessels, processes, etc. Comptroller a description of the processes and of all by the the vessels, utensils, pipes and fittings intended for Comptroller. use in the manufacture or processing of spirits.

(2) The Comptroller may approve such processes, vessels, utensils, pipes and fittings subject to such conditions (if any) as he may specify.

(3) Upon payment by a distiller of the appropriate duty specified in the First Schedule to the Manufacture and Sale of Spirits Act, 1962 (Act 154) the Comptroller shall issue to such a distiller a licence which shall contain such particulars, terms and conditions as the Comptroller may determine ' ; and

(b) by the substitution, for the definition of " distiller " in regulation 57 thereof of the following:—

" 'distiller ' means any person who has been directed in pursuance of section 2 of the Manufacture and Sale of Spirits Act, 1962 (Act 154) to be placed under the control of the Excise Ordinance (No. 31 of 1953)."

2. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation at the same time as the Excise (Spirits) Regulations, 1963 (L.I. 264).
