

- (d) The Traditional Authority in the area of the bush fire commits an offence.

Establishment of Town, Area or Unit Fire Volunteer Squad

8. There shall be establishment in every Town, Area or Unit a Fire Volunteer Squad.

Penalty

9. Any person who negligently or deliberately causes fire out-break shall be liable on conviction to a fine of 50 Penalty units payable to the Assembly or in default, to a term of imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months or both.

SECTION 11: (GROWING AND SALE OF CROPS) BYE-LAWS 2015

Requirements and Registration

1. No person shall grow crops at a place other than on land within his/her premises unless he/she has registered with the Medical Officer of Health furnishing his name and address and the description of the site where the crops are to be grown.

Watering and Irrigation

2. No crops shall be Watered or Irrigated by the effluent from a drain from any premises or any surface water from a drain which is fed by water from a street drainage.

Infected Person

3. No person who has a discharging wound or sore or the symptoms of any infectious disease shall take part in the growing or sale of crops.

Sale of Crops

4. No crops shall be displayed for sale on a road, pavement or sidewalk.

Crops Unfit for Sale

5. (i) The Medical Officer of Health may, where he considers necessary in the interest of public health, declare any crops unfit for human consumption.
(iii) No crops declared unfit of human consumption shall be sold, offered or displayed for sale as human food.

Penalty

6. A person who contravenes any of these Bye-Laws commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of 50 penalty units payable to Atwima Kwanwo District Assembly or in default to the payment of the fine, to a term of imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months or both.

Interpretation

7. In these Bye-Laws unless the context otherwise requires – “Crops” means lettuce, tomatoes, radishes, onions, cucumber, water melon, oranges, bananas, kontomire or any other agricultural produce likely to be eaten in an uncooked state.

SECTION 10: (DRAINAGE OF WASTE WATER) BYE-LAWS 2015

Duty to Provide Linkage Drain

1. Every household, owner or occupier of premises shall connect a linkage of waste except sewage to the main drain or culvert wherever available.

Application

2. These Bye-Laws apply to premises such as dwelling houses, industrial or commercial houses, structures or sheds whether or not permanently occupied within the District Assembly area of jurisdiction.

Linkage Drain

3. The Linkage Drain shall be made of concrete and shall also be covered.

Exception

4. Any household, owner or occupier of premises shall build a soak-away to take care of waste water in places where a drain or culvert is not available.

Penalty

5. A person who contravenes any provisions of these Bye-Laws commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a maximum fine not exceeding 50 penalty units payable to Atwima Kwanwoma District Assembly or in default to a term of imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months or both.
