

40. Kwahu East District Assembly (Exportation of Commodities) Bye-Laws, 2020

1. Title

These bye-laws may be cited as the Kwahu East District Assembly (Exportation of Commodities) bye-laws,

2. Exportation Fee

It shall be the duty of any exporter of commodities from the Kwaebibirem District to pay exportation fee of an amount prescribed by the Kwahu East District Assembly (hereinafter referred to as “the Assembly”) in a Fee Fixing Resolution.

3. Basis of Assessment

The basis of assessment of exportation fee shall be

- (a) The tonnage of the vehicle conveying the commodities or
- (b) The container in which the commodities are being exported
- (c) Or any other measure the Assembly may deem appropriate and fair

4. Proof of Payment

Proof of payment of exportation fee shall be a receipt issued by an accredited agent of the Assembly stating date, amount, type of commodity, registration number and tonnage of vehicle and or quantity of goods.

5. Penalty

Any person who contravenes any section of these bye-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine of twenty penalty units or in default to a term of imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months.

6. Failure to stop at a check point

Any driver who fails to stop at a check point of the Assembly for the purpose of paying exportation fee shall pay a fine equivalent to ten times the amount he is expected to pay as per the Fee Fixing Resolution.
