Kwahu West Municipal Assembly (Sale of Meat and fish) Bye-laws, 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Kwahu West Municipal Assembly in section 181 (1) of the Local Governance Act, 2016 (Act 936), these Bye-laws are hereby made:

1. Sale of Fish or Meat shall be on License

No person shall sell, expose or offer for sale any fresh or frozen meat or fish without a license duly granted by the Assembly.

2. Fee for Licence

The fee for a license for the sale of fresh/frozen meat shall be as fixed by resolution of the Assembly.

3. Only Fresh Meat Approved by Municipal Health Superintendent Shall be Sold No person shall-

(a) sell or otherwise dispose of any fresh meat at any shop, market or other place:

(b) distribute for sale of any fresh meat, unless it is the flesh of animal slaughtered in the Kwahu West Municipal Assembly.

Provided that where fresh meat duly stamped by a recognized slaughter-house authority (is brought into the area) from other parts of Ghana or from outside Ghana the Assembly may allow the sale of the fresh meat on the approval and certification by the Assembly's Municipal Health Superintendent confirming its fitness for human consumption.

4. Meat and Fish to be Stored in Approved Containers

All meat and fish for sale shall be stored in containers approved by the Municipal Health Superintendent or Officer of the Assembly appointed for the purpose.

5. Meat and Fish to be Protected Against Flies and Dust

All meat and meat be protected against files and dust.

6. Offence

Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of these Bye-laws or any condition imposed by a license hereunder shall be liable to a fine not exceeding 5 penalty units or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding three months

7. Application these Bye-laws shall apply within the area of authority of the Assembly.
