SECTION 24: (LORRY PARKS) BYE-LAWS 2015

Provision of Lorry Parks

1. (i) No driver of a motor vehicle plying for public hire or fare shall operate in the public park of any town within the area of authority of the Atwima Kwanwoma District Assembly (hereafter referred to as "The Assembly") between 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. load passengers or goods except at the place provided for the purpose by the Assembly.
- (iii) Nothing in these Bye-Laws shall prevent:-
 - (a) The loading or unloading of passengers or goods to or from any private store, dwelling house, shops or other premises within the town.
 - (b) The loading or unloading of passengers or goods at any place within such town in the event of an accident or bona fide breakdown of the vehicle.

Lorry Park Fees

2. There shall be payable for the use of the lorry park in respect of each motor vehicle a Fee Fixed by Resolution of the Assembly.

Every driver of a motor vehicle shall each day, on entering the lorry park, pay a fee to the person appointed by the Assembly to be in charge of the lorry park (hereinafter called "The Attendant") and shall produce the ticket to the attendant and any driver failing to produce such ticket shall be deemed to be that the vehicle is first entering the lorry park.

Mode of Entering a Park, Etc.

3. Every driver of a lorry park shall:-
 - (i) Enter the lorry park by the opening entrance and leave by the opening exit.;
 - (ii) Park his/her motor vehicles in the lorry park in such space as may be indicated by him/her by the attendant;
 - (iii) Secure his/her motor vehicle from movement by keeping the hand brake on or adopting effective means; and
 - (iv) Refrain from unnecessary sounding the horn or other warning instruments.

Nuisance

4. No person shall cause nuisance in the lorry park.

Fuel Filling Station not to be used as a Lorry Park

5. (i) No person shall use fuel station as a lorry park except for purposes of refueling.
(ii) The Assembly may revoke the licence of any fuel dealer who allows his/her fuel filling station to be used as a lorry park.

Bookmen

6. (i) Any person or group of persons who wish to operate at any of the Assembly's approved lorry parks as Bookmen shall obtain a licence from the Assembly to do so.
(ii) The cost of the licence shall be a Fee Fixed by Resolution of the Assembly subject to the good conduct and good performance of the particular Bookman
(iii) The Assembly may revoke the licence of any Bookman for acts prejudicial to the good discipline and operation of any of its lorry parks.

Prohibition of Hawking in Lorry Parks

7. No person shall carry on any hawking, trade or business within the lorry park or on the foot-way or road-ways immediately around the park other than the trade or business of vendors of petrol or oil at such sites in the parks as may from time to time be allocated for such purposes by the Assembly and also sales by registered stall holders in the bread and hot meal stalls.

No Person to Sell "Akpeteshie" in Lorry Park

8. No person shall sell "akpeteshie" or any intoxicating liquor in a lorry park

Persons Shall not Offload a Vehicle on a Street or Lane

9. (i) Any person who brings foodstuffs or animals to the market to sell shall not park the vehicle for the purpose of offloading on the lanes or street adjacent to the park.
(ii) Foodstuffs or livestock unloaded at a lorry park shall be conveyed to the appropriate market by their owners within two (2) hours.

Offence

10. (i) Any person who contravenes the provisions of Section 2 and 4 of these Bye-Laws shall pay on the spot fine **One Hundred Ghana Cedis (GH¢100.00)** to the Assembly or failing to comply with that, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding 50 Penalty units payable to the Assembly or in default to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six (6) months or both.

(ii) Except otherwise provided in these Bye-Laws any person who contravenes any of these Bye-Laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding **Two Hundred Ghana Cedis (GH¢200.00)** or in default to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months.

Application

11. These Bye-Laws shall apply within the area of authority of the Assembly.

Revocation

12. Any Bye-Laws on lorry parks in existence in the area of authority of the Assembly before the coming into force of these Bye-Laws are hereby revoked.

SECTION 25: (CEMETERY) BYE-LAWS 2015

Title

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Atwima Kwanwoma District Assembly (Cemetery) Bye-Laws, 2015 and shall apply within the area of authority of the Assembly.

Control of Cemetery

2. The Atwima Kwanwoma District (hereinafter referred to as “The Assembly”) shall for the purpose of and subject to these Bye-Laws have the control and management of all cemeteries within the area of authority of the Assembly.

Plan for Cemetery
