34. The Kwahu East District Assembly (Removal of Night-Soil/Septage) ByeLaws, 2020

1. Control of private latrines

In all communities under the jurisdiction of the Assembly the removal of night-soil/septage from all premises in which private toilets are kept shall be under the control of the Assembly and no person other than a person authorized by the Assembly shall remove nightsoil/septage from such private latrines.

2. Use of Pan Latrines

The use of pan latrines within the jurisdiction of the Assembly is hereby abolished. Premises with such facilities shall convert them to an approved toilet facility

3. Notice to Assembly

The owner or occupier of any premises in which private toilets are kept shall give notice of dislodging such toilets to the Assembly which shall provide services for the dislodging of same. The Assembly may also provide such services through its accredited agents.

4. Fees payable to Assembly

There shall be payable to the Assembly or its accredited agents by the owner or occupier in respect of the dislodgement services provided by the Assembly under these bye-laws, a fee as may be fixed from time to time by resolution of the Assembly.

5. Penalty

Any person other than a person authorized by the Assembly who dislodges toilet from any premises to which the provisions of these bye-laws apply, and every owner or occupier who permits any unauthorized person to dislodge same or who fails to notify the Assembly as required by the provisions of these by-laws, shall be guilty of an offence and on summary conviction thereof shall be liable to a fine not exceeding hundred (100) penalty units or in default to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months.
