

Made at a meeting of the Atwima Kwanwoma District Assembly held on the 18th day of December, 2014.

SECTION 5: (VEHICLE DEALERS) BYE-LAWS 2015

Application to Operate as Vehicle Dealer

1. No person shall operate as a Vehicle Dealer or keep vehicles in an enclosure or open space for sale by himself or on behalf of others in the administrative area of the District Assembly without applying to the District Assembly for permission to do so.

Vehicle Dealer's Permit

2. An application for a Vehicle Dealer's Permit shall comply with the following conditions
 - (i) The park or ground on which the vehicle are displayed shall be suitably fenced; and
 - (ii) There shall be a conspicuous sign board advertising the sales; and
 - (iii) The park shall be adequately equipped with firefighting equipment.

Fees

3. The District Assembly may grant a permit to engage in the sale of vehicles on the payment of a fee as shall be specified by a Resolution of the District Assembly.

Submission of Site Plan

4. An application submitted to the District Assembly shall be accompanied with three (3) Site Plans of the area where the park or enclosure is to be located.

Sitting of Office

5. A site for sale or display of vehicle shall have an office from which receipts of sales of vehicles shall be issued.

Dimensions

6. A park or enclosure used for the purpose of dealing in the sale of vehicles shall not be less than 61 metres x 30 metres.

Discretion to Withdraw Dealer's Licence

7. Notwithstanding any sanction which may be applied by the District Assembly, the Assembly may withdraw a Vehicle Dealer's licence for stated reasons upon giving the dealer thirty (30) days notice where there is a continuous contravention of these Bye-Laws.

Individual Vehicle Sale Exempted

8. For the avoidance of doubt, these Bye-Laws shall not apply to any disposal of a vehicle by an individual who is not a general dealer in vehicles.

Penalty

9. A person who contravenes the provisions of these Bye-Laws commits an offence and shall on summary conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding 50 penalty units payable to Atwima Kwanwoma District Assembly or in default to a term of imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months or both.

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SECTION 7: (EXCAVATION IN STREETS) BYE-LAWS 2015

Permit for Excavation

1. (i) No person shall within the District Assembly area of Administration undertake any excavation on any road without obtaining a permit from the District Assembly for that purpose.
(ii) Where with such consent a person undertakes any excavation in any street he/she shall:
 - (a) At his/her own expenses cause it to be sufficiently fenced;
 - (b) Maintain sufficient light or a reflective device in a proper place on or near it at all times until the excavation is completed;
 - (c) Refill the excavated area to the satisfaction of the District Assembly within such time as the District Assembly may specify.

Application for Permit

2. (i) An application for a permit to carry out an excavation exercise in any street shall be made in writing addressed to the District Engineer of the Assembly Roads Department before excavation work begins.
(ii) The application for the permit shall be in the form specified in the Schedule to these Bye-Laws and shall only be signed by the District Assembly Roads Engineer or any other competent Officer when the application is approved.
(iii) A permit issued under the provisions of these Bye-Laws may be granted subject to conditions as the District Assembly may determine in the interest of public safety and order within the District Assembly'

Permit Fee
